

Wireless Networks and WinSuite 3.51 & EE

As more and more schools look to having wireless equipment so they can have mobile computer suites. There maybe some issues we will have to deal with but after we did some tests on this using our own mobile equipment we found that WinSuite works perfectly using a wireless network.

Make sure that with the client machines that you are using for a wireless connection that Service Pack 2 has been installed.

When setting up your wireless clients you must ensure that you only have the drivers for the card installed and that there is NO 3rd party software installed to control the card let Windows XP do this.

When there was a connection made and everything is talking to each other, install WinSuite on both the server and the clients. Set up your WinSuite step by step and every time you make a change log off and log on the client to ensure that the change has been implemented correctly.

From our tests we found that WinSuite works with a wireless connection with screen manager, no taskbar and no start button.

The kit we used was a Linksys Access Point – Model WAP54G & Linksys 802.11g – WPC54G card.
